THE MANAGING PARTNER FORUM ANNOUNCES INAUGURAL NATIONAL LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

Conference to be held on November 16, 2011 in Chicago. Registration is Now Open.

Atlanta - August 29, 2011 - The Managing Partner Forum announces that its 2011 Fall Leadership Conference will be held on Wednesday, November 16, 2011 at the University Club of Chicago. Registration is now open for leaders of US law firms with ten or more lawyers.

"Our mission is to help law firm leaders be more effective in their challenging, often ill-defined, roles, and the time has come for us to move beyond state and regional conferences to a national platform," says John Remsen, Jr., President and CEO. "Attendees have always enjoyed our high-level participants and our interactive format, and we do not intend to change that. We will continue to work with the same format, but we will market the conference to a national audience."

Programs are designed especially for law firm managing partners by law firm managing partners and are developed and refined based on input from past participants and the Forum Advisory Board. The Advisory Board consists of thirty six (36) managing partners, mostly from mid-size law firms. Topics often focus on issues such as firm leadership, strategic planning, compensation systems, growth strategies, and marketing and business development.

Since 2002, The Managing Partner Forum has presented nineteen (19) law firm leadership conferences in Atlanta, Boston, Chicago, Dallas, Houston, Miami, and St. Louis. More than 700 firm leaders from 600 law firms have participated in previous programs which, historically, have had a state or regional focus. This will be the first time The Managing Partner Forum will present a national conference.
